Administrative Approval is accorded to the **Construction of Non-Motorable Walk Way around Wular Lake from Banyari Bridge to Naaz Nallah (phase I) , including Approach Road to Delta Park**, at a technically vetted cost of ₹1942.26 lakh (**Rupees nineteen crore forty two lakh twenty six thousand only**) to be completed in two working seasons with abstract cost details as follows;

The administrative approval is accorded subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions;



1. That the proposals are strictly devised and designed as per latest relevant I.S codes and specifications of PWD/CPWD and same is authenticated and proof checked by the competent authority (NIT/DIQC).
2. That the rates for the items, not covered in JK SSR or any other relevant Schedule, shall conform to Analysis of rates based on authentic Data Book, to be computed and approved by the competent authority well before invitation of tenders in accordance with set codal procedures.
3. That the lump-sum provisions, either in terms of percentage or fixed as made for certain components of the DPR are provisional and shall be subject to detailed estimates based on actual details/requirements and relevant rates, to be framed and approved by competent authorities well before invitation of tenders in accordance with set codal procedures.
4. That e-tendering mode is followed for fixation of the award of contract for execution of the project. Fragmentation of project, while tendering, is not allowed.
5. That the Technical Vetting is exclusively for the purpose of Accord of Administrative Approval and shall not be construed as any rate approval.
6. That all rules/orders and instructions issued by the Government from time to time shall be observed while incurring the expenditure against allocated amount.
7. That Contour mapping and structural design of the site is prepared.
8. That the photographic records of the works with GPS coordinate shall be obtained before releasing the payment.
9. That the work shall be executed strictly as per the provision and specification of the sanctioned estimates/guidelines.
10. That there is no time or cost overrun involved while completing the job and said time line is strictly adhered to.
11. That shall in no way be diverted for any other purpose or to any other work.
12. That the rates are genuine /reasonable and validated/applicable for the period of the contract.
13. That physical and financial progress report of the work shall be submitted to the Administrative department.
14. That the Environmental and Social compliance measures with mitigation measures shall be adhere to.
15. That soil testing report and NOC from the Regulatory Authorities are obtained.
16. That all other formalities as required in terms of GFR 2017 shall be applicable
