Administrative approval is accorded to the Construction of Forest Resource Management Centre (**ICT Lab**) at Bachan Depot, Narwal, Jammu within the premises of available patch of land measuring 6.5 Hectares having a built up area of 3311 Square Meter; at a technically vetted cost of ₹ **986.42 lakh** (Rupees nine crore eighty six lakh and forty-two thousand only) with facilities for housing Data Centre, Training Hall, Control and Command Room, Instrument Servers & Backup Rooms, Administrative Units and Office of the Pr. Chief Conservator of Forests & HoFF.

The administrative approval is accorded subject to fulfillment of the following conditions;

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1. That the proposals are strictly devised and designed as per latest relevant I.S codes and specifications of PWD/CPWD and same is authenticated and proof checked by the competent authority (NIT/DIQC).
  2. That the electrical/mechanical Components are authenticated and technically vetted by the competent authorities of relevant field.
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3. That the standard specifications are followed as per CPWD, NBC and I.S standards.
4. That the work done/allotted part of the project has been executed as per approved design, checked and vetted by competent authority in accordance with codal procedures.
5. That the contracts for executed/allotted part of the project have been awarded on competitive and reasonable rates in accordance with the set codal provisions and by following set guidelines/procedures, governing the field.
6. That the rates for the items, not covered in JKSSR or any other relevant Schedule, shall conform to Analysis of rates based on authentic Data Book, to be computed and approved by the competent authority well before invitation of tenders in accordance with the set codal procedures.
7. That the lump-sum provisions, either in terms of percentage or fixed as made for certain components of the DPR are provisional and shall be subject to detailed estimates based on actual details/requirements and relevant rates, to be framed and approved by competent authorities well before invitation of tender in accordance with set codal procedures.
8. That e-tendering mode is followed for fixation of the award of contract for execution of the project, fragmentation of project, while tendering, is not allowed.
9. That the technical vetting is exclusively for the purpose of accord of administrative approval and shall not be construed as any rate approval.
10. That all rules/orders and instructions issued by the Government from time to time be observed while incurring expenditure against allocated amount.
11. That contour mapping and structural design of the site is prepared.
12. That the photographic record of the works with GPS coordinates shall be obtained before releasing the payment.
13. That the work shall be executed strictly as per the provision and specification sanctioned estimates/ guidelines.
14. That there is no time or cost overrun involved while completing the job and said time line is strictly adhered to.
15. That shall in no be diverted for any other purpose or to any other work.
16. That the rates are genuine/reasonable and validated / applicable for the period of the contract.
17. That Physical and financial progress reports are submitted regularly to the administrative department.

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18. That the environmental and social compliance measures with mitigation measures shall be adhered to.
19. That Soil Testing Report and NOC from the Regulatory Authorities are obtained.
20. That all other formalities as required in terms of GFR 2017 shall be applicable.
