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**Subject:** Re-validation of funds under CSS "Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats" under component 'Recovery Programme for Critically endangered species and habitats'-Snow Leopard.

Sanction is accorded to the revalidation of an unspent balance of Rs 66.04 lakh (Rupees Sixty Six lakh Four thousand) only as central share authorized through BEAMS in favour of Chief Wildlife Warden, J&K, Srinagar for utilization during the current financial year 2019-20 for the implementation of approved Annual Plan of Operation under component 'Recovery Programme for Critically endangered species and habitats'-Snow Leopard of CSS "Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitats".

The revalidation of funds is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- (i) The expenditure shall be booked strictly for the activities approved under Annual Plan of Operation during 2018-19 as per approved rates/norms and also as per guidelines of the scheme besides no liability shall be created in any case;
- (ii) The expenditure shall be made strictly as according to the classification under which funds have been authorized;
- (iii) DDO shall complete all the codal formalities and also entertain complete classification under which funds have been authorized before presenting the bills at the treasuries;
- (iv) The funds so released/revalidated shall not be available for re-appropriation/diversion at any level;
- (v) Treasury Officer shall not entertain bill without complete classification under which funds have been authorized;
- (vi) Treasury Officer shall not allow parking or drawal of funds in the Civil Deposit without the prior concurrence of the Finance Department;
- (vii) All the sanctions/approvals and clearance shall be in place before drawal of money from the Treasury;
- (viii) The utilization certificate is furnished to the Administrative Department after expenditure is incurred and definitely well before 31-03-2020 for its submission to Finance Department/ Government of India;

- (ix) There shall be no overlapping of funding from any other source such as CSS/Flagship programme/ Capex Budget or any other source of funding;
- (x) FA/CAO of Directorate of Wildlife Warden, J&K shall vouchsafe the utilization of funds;
- (xi) The progress report both financial and physical shall be submitted to Administrative Department;
- (xii) The implementing agency shall ensure that the expenditure as well as covering of the area has not already been covered/incurred out of any other scheme under Capex Budget or Non-plan Budget.
