In pursuance of Rule 3 of J&K Daily Rated Workers/Work Charged Employees (Regularization) Rules, 1994, sanction is accorded to the creation of 01 (One) temporary post of Helper in the pay scale of Rs. 2550-3200 (pre-revised) for regularization of service of Shri Mohd Ayoub Bangroo S/O Mohd Sultan R/O Batmaloo, Srinagar Daily Rated Worker of South Circle Bijbehara, Forest(Territorial) w.e.f 01-04-2001, subject to the fulfilment of following terms and conditions:-

1. The regularization order of Daily Rated Worker shall be issued by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests J&K, subject to the fulfilment of following terms and conditions :-
 - a) That he is a Permanent Resident of the State of Jammu and Kashmir.
 - b) That on the date of his initial appointment, his age was within the minimum and maximum age limit as prescribed for appointment in Government Services;
 - c) That he is not retiree from any State or Central Government service or any Local Body, Public Sector Undertaking or Autonomous Body in or outside the State;
 - d) That his work and conduct has remained satisfactory during the period he worked as Daily Rated Worker and no disciplinary proceedings are pending against him.
 - e) That he has continuously worked in the Department prior to 31-01- 1994 till date and fully qualify as per SRO-64 of 1994;
 - f) That no enquiry/investigation i.e. departmental or in Vigilance Organization / Crime Branch / Police Station is pending against the incumbent.
 - g) That the incumbent fulfill all the terms and conditions as laid down in SRO 64 of 1994 and record note of 11th meeting of Empowerment Committee held on 13-09-
