Sanction is accorded to the revalidation of an amount of Rs 341.17 lakh (Rupees three crore forty one lakh seventeen thousand) only **through BEAMS** in favour of Chief Wildlife warden, J&K Jammu for utilization during the current financial year 2018-19 for implementation of Annual Plan of Operations (APOs) approved by Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under the component – Protection of Wildlife Outside Protected Areas of Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Integrated Development of Wildlife Habitat" strictly.

The revalidation of funds is subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:

- i. The expenditure shall be booked strictly as per APO approved by GOI, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change vide their No: 26-2/2014 WL-I/60 dated: 22-12-2015 and as per guidelines of the scheme and no liability shall be created in any case;
 - ii. **The expenditure shall be made strictly as according to the classification under which funds have been authorized through BEAMS;**
 - iii. **DDO shall complete all codal formalities and also entertain complete classification under which funds have been authorized before presenting the bills at different treasuries ;**
 - iv. The funds so revalidated shall not be available for re-appropriation/diversion at any level;
 - v. The utilization certificate is furnished to the Administrative Department after expenditure is incurred and definitely before 31-03-2019 for its submission to Government of India/Finance Department;
 - vi. There shall be no overlapping of funding from any other source such as CSS/Flagship programme/ Capex Budget or any other source of funding;
 - vii. FA&CAO/Accounts Officer of Directorate of Wildlife Warden, J&K shall vouchsafe the utilization of funds;
 - viii. The progress report both financial and physical shall be submitted to Administrative Department;
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- ix. The implementing agency shall ensure that the expenditure as well as covering of the area has not already been covered/incurred out of any other scheme under Capex Budget or Non-plan Budget;
- x. Treasury Officers shall not allow parking or drawal of funds in the Civil Deposit withy out the prior concurrence of the Finance Department;
- xi. All the sanctions/approvals and clearances shall be in place before drawal of money from the Treasury.


