**Subject:** Scaling up "Green Jammu and Kashmir Drive" with involvement of different line departments during the year 2020-21.

Sanction is hereby accorded to organize an integrated plantation drive to double the plantation target achieved during previous year, under the Green J&K Initiative by involving different line departments, local panchayats, educational institutions, army, para-military forces, police and civil society, to plant 100 lakh trees covering 15,000 hectares of degraded forest areas during the year 2020-21 for which tree saplings shall be provided by the Forest Department. It is further directed that:-

- i) The Program will be called "Green J&K Drive-2020".
- ii) Panchayati Raj Institutions will be involved in plantation under the program with provision for sharing of usufruct, after approval of competent authority.
- iii) Plantations in Degraded Forests and other areas, except the plantations on common lands by Panchayats, will be declared as Protected Forests.
