Sanction is hereby accorded to the charging of rates on account of various services/ activities at Jambu Zoo (Jammu), as per the details given below:-

The rates of above services shall be valid for 4 hours except photography and videography. The term '**Day**' for the daily rates shall be the period between opening of Zoo in the morning and its closing in the evening as shall be notified by Wildlife Warden/ Director of Jambu Zoo.

Besides, the rate/charges of other services are as under:-

03	Volunteer Registration	₹5000/-per individual for registration with annual renewal fee of ₹1000/-	Initially 50 volunteers to be imparted basic knowledge in animal ecology, behavior, basic ornithology, public relation building etc. Qualified volunteers can be involved as Zoo Guides which would charge ₹500/- for a group of visitors. The guidelines for such volunteers shall be notified separately.
04	Animal Adoption per month	i) Herbivore=₹3000/- ii) Small cats=₹2500/- iii) Tiger/Lion= ₹7000/- iv) Leopard =₹6000/- v) Crocodile/ reptile= ₹1000/- vi) Birds =₹500/-	Amount on a/c of feed, fodder, salt lick etc. shall be incurred from the concerned Detailed-Head Material & Supply/Raw Material.
05	Services on rental basis	i) Umbrella=₹20/- ii) Rain Coats=₹50/- iii) Gum/Canvas Shoes= ₹25/-	

The Sanction is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The initial inaugural Week may be kept free for popularizing the Zoo.
2. The receipts/ revenue generated shall be remitted into Govt. Treasury on the same day or next working day.
3. The fee can be reviewed after six months based on the response.
4. The rates are inclusive of all kind of taxes & outsourcing charges which can be upto 50% of the approved rates.


