Subject: Premature retirement of Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper, Department of Wildlife Protection in terms of Article 226(2) of Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services Regulations, 1956.

**Government Order No. : 98 - JK (FST) of 2021
Dated : 14 - 09- 2021**

Whereas, the Internal Committee of Forest, Ecology and Environment Department, constituted vide Government Order No. 24-JK (FST) of 2021 dated 16.03.2021, scrutinized the service record of Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper, Department of Wildlife Protection; and

Whereas, based on the details, the Internal Committee observed that since the employee Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper has completed 48 years of age and falls under broad conditions laid down in SO 324 dated 22-10-2020; and

Whereas, the Internal Committee recommended the case of Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper for retirement and further placement before the Review Committee for consideration under the provisions of S.O. 324 dated 22.10.2020; and,

Whereas, the Review Committee, constituted vide Government Order No.07-JK(GAD) of 2021 dated 05.01.2021, under Article 226(2) of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations, 1956 observed that the official Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper, while holding a post in the Department, has not performed the duties efficiently and his official conduct has remained doubtful/unsatisfactory and concluded that it would not be in the larger interest of the public and the Government to retain him in the Government Service further; and

Whereas, the Review committee recommended that Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper be retired from the Government Service in the public interest in terms of Article 226(2) of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations, 1956; and

Whereas, the Competent Authority has given approval to retire Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper, Department of Wildlife Protection from the Government Service, in terms of Article 226(2) of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations, 1956, as it would be in public interest and Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper would be paid pay and allowances equivalent to three months, in lieu of notice period; and

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 226(2) of the Jammu & Kashmir Civil Services Regulations, 1956, Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper, Department of Wildlife Protection having already attained 58 years of age, shall retire from service with effect from forenoon of 15th September 2021.

Further, it is ordered that pay and allowances equivalent to three months in lieu of notice period shall be paid to Sh. Leela Krishan, Helper by the Department of Wildlife Protection.
