Terms of References:

- I. to undertake Half Yearly review of records of officers All Indian Forest Service officers who have completed 15 years of qualifying service or have completed 25 years of qualifying service or attained the age of 50 years, whichever is earlier subject to the condition that an officer(Direct Recruit) should have completed minimum 15 years of qualifying service and in the case of the State Service Officers appointed to an All India Service by promotion or by selection, they should have completed a minimum of 5 years of actual service in the respective All India Service.
- II. To identify, for requirement in public interest under Rule16 (3) of AIS (DCRB) Rules, 1958 with broad objectives to weed out officers of doubtful integrity and secondly, to weed out officers who have outlived their utility and have become inefficient or ineffective.


